Strengths

Hawthorne's richly diverse learning community and commitment to continuous improvement for all students are key strengths of our learning community. Ongoing improvement efforts facilitate consistent high quality, rigorous, and supportive learning environments for all students. Four-year-old kindergarten through 3rd grade classrooms have approximately 18 students per classroom. Fourth and 4th grade classrooms have approximately 25 students per classroom. The majority of instructional staff have Master's degrees in education or are working toward Master's degrees in various area of education. Hawthorne's 4K-5th Spanish DBE – Development Bilingual Education program and well trained ESL/BRT/BRS staff work in partnership with all staff to support the unique needs of Hawthorne's 46% English Language Learner student population.

Progress

Hawthorne's 3rd – 5th MAP – Measures of Academic Progress Spring 2017 – Spring 2018 growth results were above the district average for 3rd – 5th gr students overall and for Caucasian, African American, Hispanic, low income, Special Education, ELL and Advanced Learners. 3rd - 5th African American and Hispanic students exceeded their percent proficient increase targets as disaggregated groups identified in our 2017-18 school improvement plan. In addition, Hawthorne fully implemented new Bridges Mathematics curriculum and instruction 5K - 5th, successfully meeting identified proficiency and growth targets in mathematics as measured by the 3rd - 5th MAP mathematics assessment.

Area for Growth

Hawthorne's 2018-19 School Improvement Plan focuses on students' continued improvement in reading, writing and social and emotional growth and progress. Through carefully designed learning tasks aligned to daily literacy learning targets and clear feedback to students, teachers will provide appropriately scaffolded standards based instruction for all students. High functioning grade level teaching teams will continue to meet weekly to analyze current student data, reflect on instruction and interventions, and make adjustments for both instruction and intervention for the following week. School staff will continue to focus on building relationships with families through two-way communication and proactive family engagement efforts. Hawthorne will also be launching our new Community School initiative.

Vision Connection

Our school supports MMSD's vision that all students acquire the skills and abilities needed to be successful, including a mastery of content areas, growth mindset, self-knowledge, creativity, wellness, interpersonal skills, confidence, cultural competence, and community connection. Through these skills and abilities, our students will graduate college, career, and community ready.

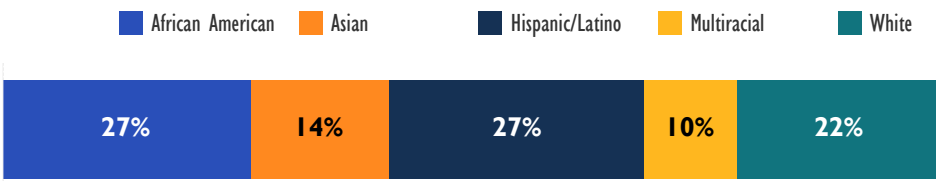

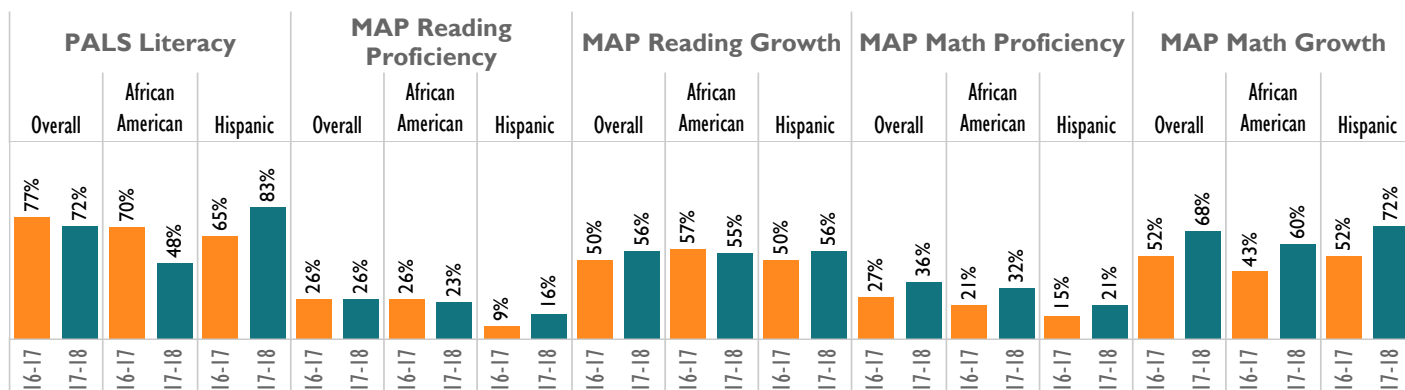

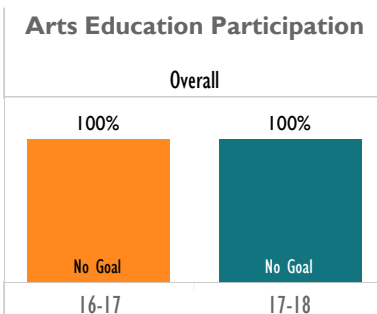
